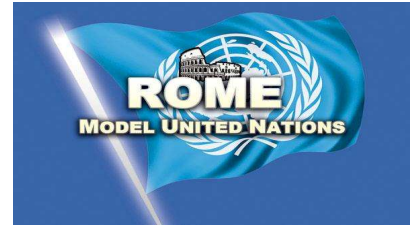

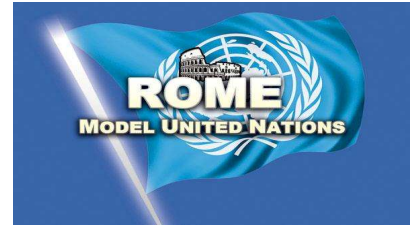

The Rome Model United Nations has concluded along these years “Exchange Program Agreements” with eminent and world-know **Model United Nations Conferences** in Italy and abroad.

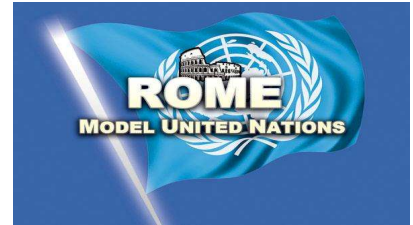
The “Exchange Program Agreement” is made by and entered by and between the RomeMUN and the hosted Conference, who usually jointly agree to be bound by specific terms and conditions, such as:



- the beginning of a mutual advertising for the recruitment of delegates (attending the respective Conferences) for both sides with a direct link to the official websites of both Conferences and through their official media (Facebook pages, Twitter account, official newsletters);
- the exchange of outstanding delegates (“Best Delegate”) from respective MUN Conferences each other, providing them with a free seat (free Conference fee and Accommodation fee, meals and shuttle transfers to and from the Conference venues included);
- the delivery of respective official certificates to all the participating delegates (necessary for obtaining the European Credit Transfer System Credits (ECTS));
- the agreements usually last (from the signing of the agreement) for a period of 12 months and shall be renewable on the same terms and conditions (if agreed among the Parties) for years to come, unless agreed upon otherwise.
